JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Behavior Specialist will provide proactive support, consultation, modeling, coaching, regular reviews, observations, Autism evaluations and written reports for students who require behavior intervention plans.

Responsibilities and requirements include:

- Oversee Center-based programs
- Conduct behavioral screenings, Functional Behavior Assessments and evaluations in a timely manner for students evaluated for Autism Spectrum Disorder..
- Develop behavioral goals that are educationally relevant and will be used in the student's educational setting.
- Coordinate with classroom teachers, other educators and parents by providing recommending strategies to enhance the student's educational progress and performance.
- Maintain all required records, forms and files including those prescribed by the program and those required by the BOCES.
- Attend and facilitate IEP meetings.
- Consult with parents regarding student needs/progress.
- Guide behavioral therapy in determining goals and measuring the effectiveness of interventions.
- Train and monitor teachers and paraprofessionals to work with students with behavioral needs.
- Participate on BOCES teams to provide expertise about autism and behavioral interventions.
- Serve as a member of school IEP teams and IEP Teams in each building.
- Demonstrate knowledge of developmental and behavioral benchmarks of students.
- Demonstrate effective written and oral communication skills.
- Ability to use web based IEP program.
- Establish and maintain effective, cooperative relationships with school personnel, students and parents.
- Scheduled, weekly visits to each building
- Center-based program consultation
- Consult/Review for all students with SED, students with Autism, and at-risk for placement
- Proactive MTSS consultation
- Collaboratively develop, review and monitor behavioral progress monitoring
